



## 2019 Senior B President's Cup Report

The 2019 President's Cup was hosted by the Kahnawake Mohawks, in Kahnawake, Quebec.

The tournament featured 8 teams: Host Kahnawake Mohawks, Ladner Pioneers (BC), St. Albert Miners (RMLL), Snake Island Musies (TNSLL), Six Nations Rivermen (OLA), Akwesasne Bucks (Can-AM), Capital Region Axemen (QSSL), Nova Scotia. The format was a full round robin. The Miners Finished third in round robin and faced Kahnawake in the Bronze Medal game. Kahnawake tied the Miners in the final game of the round robin with a buzzer beating tying goal with 0:00 showing on the clock to get to face the Miners in the Bronze medal game. In the Bronze medal game they Mohawks came out strong and made sure they won the game in front of the hometown crowd.

Because of the intensity of some of the games, the last third of the tournament was officiated using 3 on-floor officials, as well as a fourth official on the shot-clock.

Early in the week there was a very scary incident involving Kahnawake Mohawks goalie Angus Goodleaf. At the end of the first period he collapsed without a pulse on the playing surface. The quick thinking of the trainer, Kahnawake PeaceKeepers and finally paramedics and fire department performing CPR and using three separate AEDs they got him fully revived and transported to hospital. Angus was expected to recover after a surgery later in the week.

Richard Lachlan was the leading scorer of the tournament and named to the first team all-stars, and Matt Hiebert and Graedon Cornfield were selected second team all-stars.
