Proof of Vaccination Requirements

All visitors 12 years of age and older entering City of Brampton recreation centres are required to show proof of vaccination status. This applies to all participants and spectators in recreation centres, including youth, coaches, instructors, caregivers, volunteers and game officials.

Effective **January 1, 2022**, children who turn 12 years-old in 2022 (born in 2010) are to be provided a grace period of 12 weeks from their birthdate, during which they will not need to show proof of vaccination at indoor sports and recreational facilities. This will allow children the time needed to be vaccinated and meet proof of vaccination requirements. After the 12 week grace period is over, they will be required to show proof of vaccination.

Online Screening:

Effective **January 3, 2022**, all visitors will have the option to complete an online screening and contact tracing form prior to arrival at City of Brampton recreation centres. To access the online screening tool, visit [here](#). Visitors can save time by completing the pre-screening questions online using a smartphone/computer in advance of their visit. Upon arrival at the designated screening area/entrance, all visitors must show screening confirmation (green check mark) via phone. Onsite paper-based contact tracing will continue to be made available for visitors who do not wish to complete online pre-screening.

Accepted Proof of Vaccination Methods:

Effective **January 4, 2022**, patrons will be required to use the enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code and the Verify Ontario app in settings where proof of vaccination is required. The QR code can be used digitally or by printing a paper copy. Individuals can download their enhanced certificate with QR code by visiting [here](#). **Note:** Proof of a negative COVID-19 test **will not be accepted** as an alternative to proof of full vaccination.

Exemptions:

As of **January 10, 2022**, a written medical exemption will no longer be accepted to access recreation centres. To obtain a medical exemption, you must:

- ask an Ontario physician or registered nurse in the extended class to submit your exemption request directly to the public health unit where the issuer's practice is located
- once your exemption is accepted and entered into COVaxON by the public health unit, you'll be able to access your enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code through the [COVID-19 vaccination portal](#)

To prevent community spread of COVID-19 and emerging variants, Peel Public Health has updated its guidance and recommendations regarding the use of masks. These recommendations were approved by Brampton City Council on June 16, 2021:

- Non-medical masks are mandatory until the end of April 1, 2022 (Subject to change)
- With a few exceptions, all individuals entering a public indoor premise in Brampton are required to wear a non-medical mask that covers the nose, mouth and chin
- Face coverings (i.e. scarves, bandanas, neck gaiters/warmers etc.) are no longer permitted
- Masks with exhalation valves are no longer permitted
- Masks may only be removed for consumption of food or drink if an individual is seated in a designated area for that purpose

History of the Brampton Excelsior Lacrosse Club

Brampton Excelsior Lacrosse Club, recognized as the longest-running community-owned sports franchise in Canada, will celebrate 150 years of lacrosse in 2022. It is a momentous occasion for our club and an opportunity to profile our founders, member and memories. We are so excited to be hosting the Canadian Lacrosse Association (CLA) Junior "B" Championship – The Founder's Cup.

The name "Excelsiors" meaning "more lofty, still higher, ever upward" was adopted in 1871 when the sport was first introduced in Brampton and has remained a part of the franchise for more than 148 years. Over the years, lacrosse has become the bedrock of the sporting community in Brampton, and the organization has developed thousands of layers, coaches and officials at all levels of play. Many Excelsiors have been inducted into the Brampton Sports Hall of Fame, the Ontario Lacrosse Hall of Fame and the Canadian Lacrosse Hall of Fame. Memorial Arena is our home base, a shrine to the organizations history.

Our club is well versed and experienced in hosting national lacrosse events such as the Mann Cup (1992, 1998, 2002, 2008) and the Minto Cup (2009, 2017), along with numerous provincial, regional and invitational tournaments.

Brampton is a diverse, cosmopolitan, and vibrant city, with a population of over 600,000. It is the ninth largest City in Canada and fourth largest in Ontario. Brampton is part of the GTA or Greater Toronto Area. Originally known as “Flowertown of Canada” due to the Dale’s Nursery.

The City of Brampton is situated on the traditional territory of the Huron-Wendat, Haudenosaunee and Anishinaabeg.

Event Venues

Brampton Memorial Arena, 69 Elliott Street Brampton, ON L6Y 1W2

The iconic Brampton Memorial Arena will be used for Semi Final and Final play for the Founder's Cup.

This indoor arena opened its doors in 1950, named in honour of those who lost their lives during the Second World War. Officially designated as a heritage building, little has changed in this historic structure. The venue features the original wooden seats with a 1400-spectator capacity, and a natural ventilation system (no air conditioning).

The location is profiled in a number of hockey books including Ron MacLean Hockey Towns. This venue has recently undergone some structural retrofits but the interior is still a shrine to the sport of lacrosse and its evolution in Brampton. The arena bowl features an artificial turf playing carpet, two dressing rooms, press box, concession, ticket booth and administration office.
