2022 Senior Women's Division Commissioner's Report.

There was a lot of excitement in the division with the announcement of COVID 19 restrictions being lifted and a return to a normal spring box lacrosse season for 2022.

The division planning in November 2021 was positive and a plan was in place for a successful season. But COVID 19 and the loss of two formal lacrosse seasons damaged player retention to a point where three teams were unable to complete a viable roster and were forced to fold their teams.

The division moved forward with two teams, one in the North, Sherwood Park Titans and one in the South, Calgary Cougars. Challenges continued as days before their first game the Titans folded because they were unable to field a complete roster or team. In 2019 the division had five teams and ninety-seven players registered. In 2022 only one team remained, and twenty players registered.

Working with the Junior Ladies Division the schedule was adjusted, the South team reduced their number of games and played an interlocking schedule with the Junior Ladies teams

The season overall was positive, but the future of the division will depend on player retention and new team applications.
