2022, we are back! Although we did lose a few teams this year play through all the divisions was back to normal. We saw a whole slew of great games culminating with a ground-breaking performance at the Minto. Not only was the year a success on the floor it was also a success financially. Over the last handful of years, and with the help of our annual casino, the RMLL has been able to build a comfortable cash reserve. No longer do we need to approach the ALA for short term support to meet our front heavy financial obligations each year. In addition to the comfortable financial position we are also starting to build our contingency fund to make sure we take care of our future needs.

Carried over from 2021 we did not need to grant any team a payment relief program this year and with the exception of one inactive franchise all teams are up to date. With respect to that lone inactive franchise we are potentially in a situation where that will also be cleared up. The team is looking to reenter the RMLL however, as at time of writing, that has not yet been confirmed.

As noted above we had another Casino in February this year. The event was successful as we added over \$62,000 to the leagues operating funds. These funds, although restricted to only a handful of expense items, provide a great deal of opportunities for our league. The casino also allowed for nine of our member organizations to earn approximately \$6,200 for providing the needed volunteers. We will most likely not see another casino until 2024 however, there is an outside chance we could see one late in 2023. I will keep everyone up to date as the details filter in.

As in years past I conclude with my thanks to all the volunteers of our members. Any organization is only as good as it's volunteers and we seem to have a lot of great ones. In addition, as I do every year, I would like to give special thanks the Board of Directors for their efforts to help steer the RMLL. Thank you "again" Chris for the countless hours keeping everything organized and running. Thank you Duane for your leadership and representing us at the ALA level, thank you John for helping us get our regs and bylaws in order and thank you to everyone else for being the glue for all your divisions.
