The female divisions had basically conceded the fact that lacrosse was done for another season. So, there was a lot of excitement and enthusiasm when the announcement of a lacrosse season for 2021 was a go. No preparations in advance were done and many thanks to the teams, coaches, managers, and players who worked extra hard to make the season happen in a short period of time. The renamed 'Alberta Major Female Lacrosse Summer Series' had six teams, the Bandits and Titans in Edmonton, the Rage in Red Deer and Raiders, Silvertips and Cougars in Calgary. One unique feature of the Summer Series is there was only one division where Junior and Senior aged players could play together on the same team as teammates. First game started on July 8th. All six teams played five exhibition games and the Titans hosted a four team, four game festival over the August 7/8 weekend. Registration numbers boasted 132 players from the Junior division and 35 players from the Senior division. Overall, the season was a great success. No games were cancelled or postponed, team game roster numbers were good, and all teams cooperated in competition to showcase Alberta's female lacrosse talent.
