Professional Development (PD)Points	Once a coach is Comp Intro Certified, the coach must acquire 20 PD Points every 5 years to maintain their certification status. A Competitive Development Certified coach must acquire 30 PD points every 5 years to maintain their certification status.

5. Loss of Certification

If a coach does not acquire their required PD points in the 5-year span, they lose their certification status and must acquire the missing PD points to become certified again. A coach with missing PD points will not be allowed to go on the Bench for Presidents', Minto or Founders'.

6. Female Only Teams

RMLL Regulation 21.2 Each Junior and Senior Major Female Franchise must have one female coach registered as Bench Personnel on their Franchise Certificate.
